Length of Internship:

June 1-August 7, 2019 (Tentative)

Pre-requisites:

Applicants will be an ongoing or continuing college student majoring in agriculture, business, communications, or related fields. A background in agriculture as well as public relations, communications and social media skills is encouraged, but not required.

Time allotment:

Work approximately 16 hours per week, including night meetings and attendance at a few weekend events. The schedule will be very flexible, and it will be the intern's job to ensure the hours are met.

Responsibilities:

- b. Assist with planning and coordination of activities for the Bureau & Lee County Ag in the Classroom Golf Outing on June 18
- c. Assist with planning, coordination and operation of AgLand Tent and Young Leader food stand at the Lee County 4-H Fair & Junior Show
- d. Attend Summer Ag Institute and assist teachers and workshop coordinators
- e. Assist with Public Relations and outreach efforts including but not limited to e-newsletter, radio segments, press releases and social media
- f. Make contact with local libraries and assist with implementation of Summer Reading Programs
- g. Attendance at one or two LCFB Board meeting(s)
- h. Attendance at one or two Young Leader meeting(s)
- i. Assist with planning and coordination of other programs and activities as designated

Compensation:

Compensation will be paid by the Lee County Farm Bureau. Compensation will be hourly-based on schedule with standard payroll deductions. Checks will be issued bi-monthly.
